Hispanic contains articles for and about Hispanics.



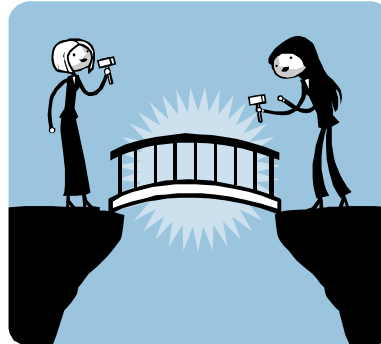

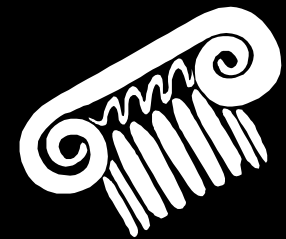
